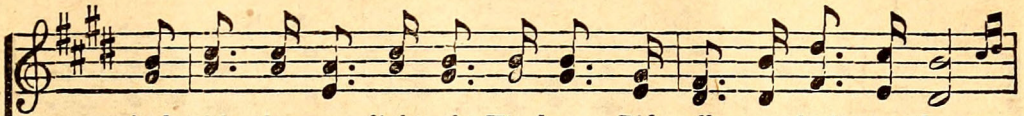

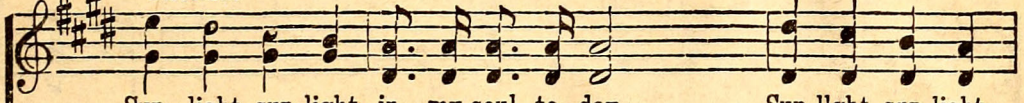
1. I wan-dered in the shades of night, Till Je - sus came to me,

5. Soon I shall see Him as He is, The Light that came to me;



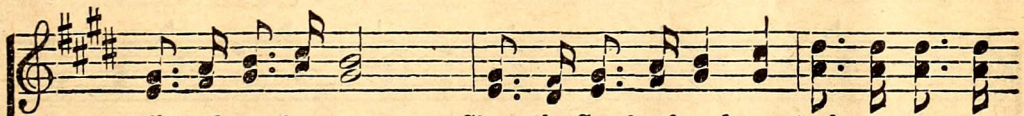
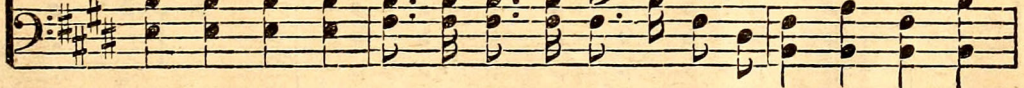

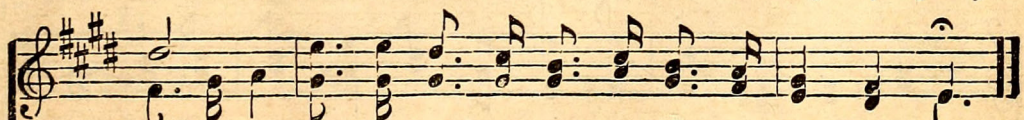
